Background: DC Jobs with Justice is a coalition of labor organizations, community groups, religious organizations and student groups dedicated to protecting the rights of working people and supporting community struggles to build a more just society.

Responsibilities:

- Assist organizers in planning and implementing solidarity activities such as rallies and other actions, door-knocking, and educational programs;
- Help coordinate annual Labor in the Pulpits program, including recruiting local congregations to participate and preparing materials about workers' rights issues;
- Support efforts to organize community support for a worker center in Ward 5; and
- Other outreach activities as needed, including phone banking, tabling at community or labor events, and making presentations at union or community meetings.

Desirable skills:

- Basic knowledge of unions and the labor movement;
- Strong written and verbal communication;
- Computer skills;
- Experience with organizing a plus.
