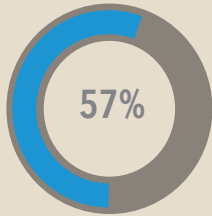

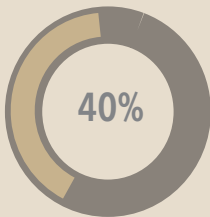

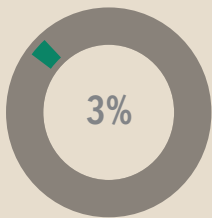

U.S. News & World Report ranks GWSB at 65th for full-time MBA programs in its 2014 rankings, with the international business program ranked 19th and the part-time MBA program ranked 61th. The magazine ranked the GWSB undergraduate program 38th and its undergraduate international business program 11th in the United States.

The 2014 ranking by Princeton Review ranked GWSB among the top 5 for "greatest opportunity for women", 8th for "Best Green MBA" and as one of the top 25 Graduate Schools in Entrepreneurship.

The Financial Times' 2013 rankings put GWSB at 41nd among U.S. business schools, 7th for corporate social responsibility/ethics and 84th worldwide.
