His primary focus at Forge was to help the Department of Defense implement a new metrics program that evaluates the return on investment for international security cooperation programs.

Before joining Forge Group, Noah was International Project Lead at Booz Allen Hamilton, supporting the Biological Threat Reduction Program. In this position, he assisted U.S. partner nations in developing sustainable biosecurity and bio-surveillance programs in the Middle East and the Caucasus.
