

Core Course and Credit Waiver Form

Core Course Waiver

Students may apply for core course waivers for program designated core courses by meeting the following criteria:

- Completed at an AACSB accredited institution
- Graduate-level and credit-bearing
- Completed within five years from the date of matriculation
- Earned a grade of *B* or better

To apply students must provide evidence of successfully completing equivalent graduate-level coursework.

A copy of the equivalent graduate course syllabus AND an official transcript showing the grade earned are required. Transcripts should be sent directly to:

Please note:

- Undergraduate coursework and/or degrees cannot be applied towards a core course requirement.
- If approved, the student does not need to complete the waived course at GWSB. However, the total number of credits required to complete the program will not be reduced and the student must replace the waived course with elective credits to fulfill graduation requirements.

Credit Waiver (MS in Project Management and Master of Tourism only)

Students may apply for up to 9 credit hours of credit waivers for the MSPM program or 3 credit hours for the MTA program for program designated requirements by meeting the following criteria:

MS in Project Management

- A current PMP certification from the Project Management Institute (3 credit hours of electives waived)
- Successful completion of the Masters Certificate in Project Management (Master's Certificate in IT Project Management excluded) offered by TwentyEighty (formerly ESI International) within the past 5 years (up to 9 credit hours waived)

Master of Tourism (3 credit hours of required or electives waived)

- Successful completion of one of the International Institute of Tourism Studies (IITS) certificate programs:
 - Event Management Certificate
 - Destination Management Certificate
 - Sport Philanthropy Certificate
 - Tourism and International Cooperation for Development Course/Cooperation with United Nations World Tourism Organization
