CHEM 1111/1112	General Chemistry (Prerequisites: High School Algebra. CHEM 1111 is a prerequisite for CHEM 1112).
GEOL 1001 OR 1005 AND GEOL 1002	Physical OR Environmental Geology AND Historical Geology. GEOL 1001 or 1005 is a prerequisite to GEOL 1002.
HONR 1033/1034	Scientific Reason & Discovery Pro seminar (Honor Students Only)
PHYS 1011/1012	General Physics I/General Physics II (Prerequisite: High School Trigonometry. PHYS 1011 is a prerequisite to PHYS 1012)
