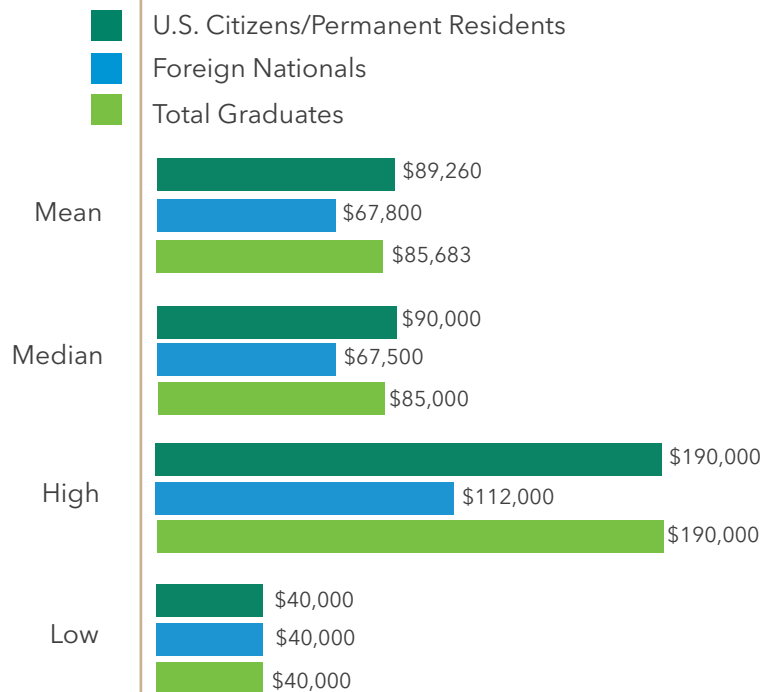


## POST GRADUATION PLANS

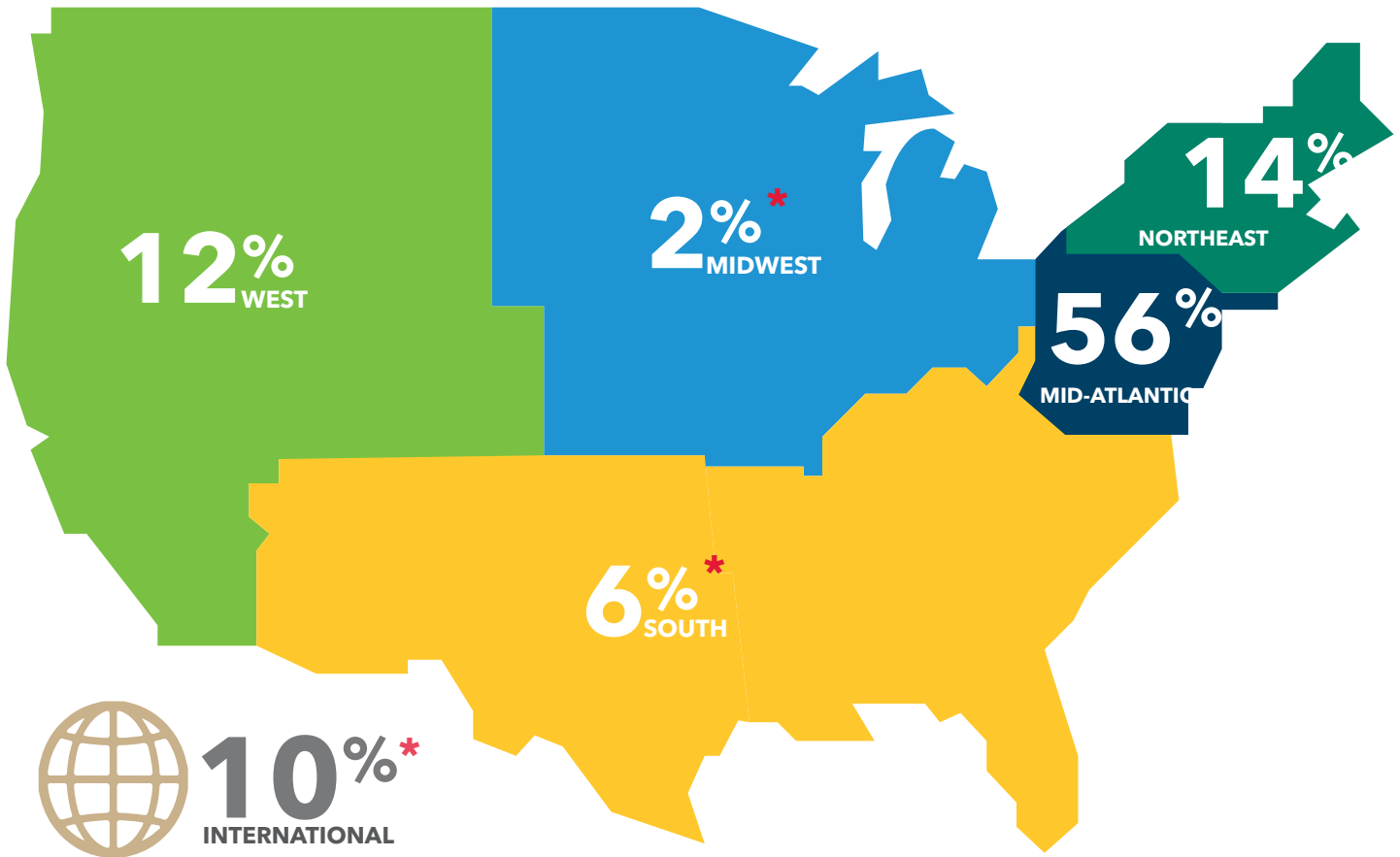

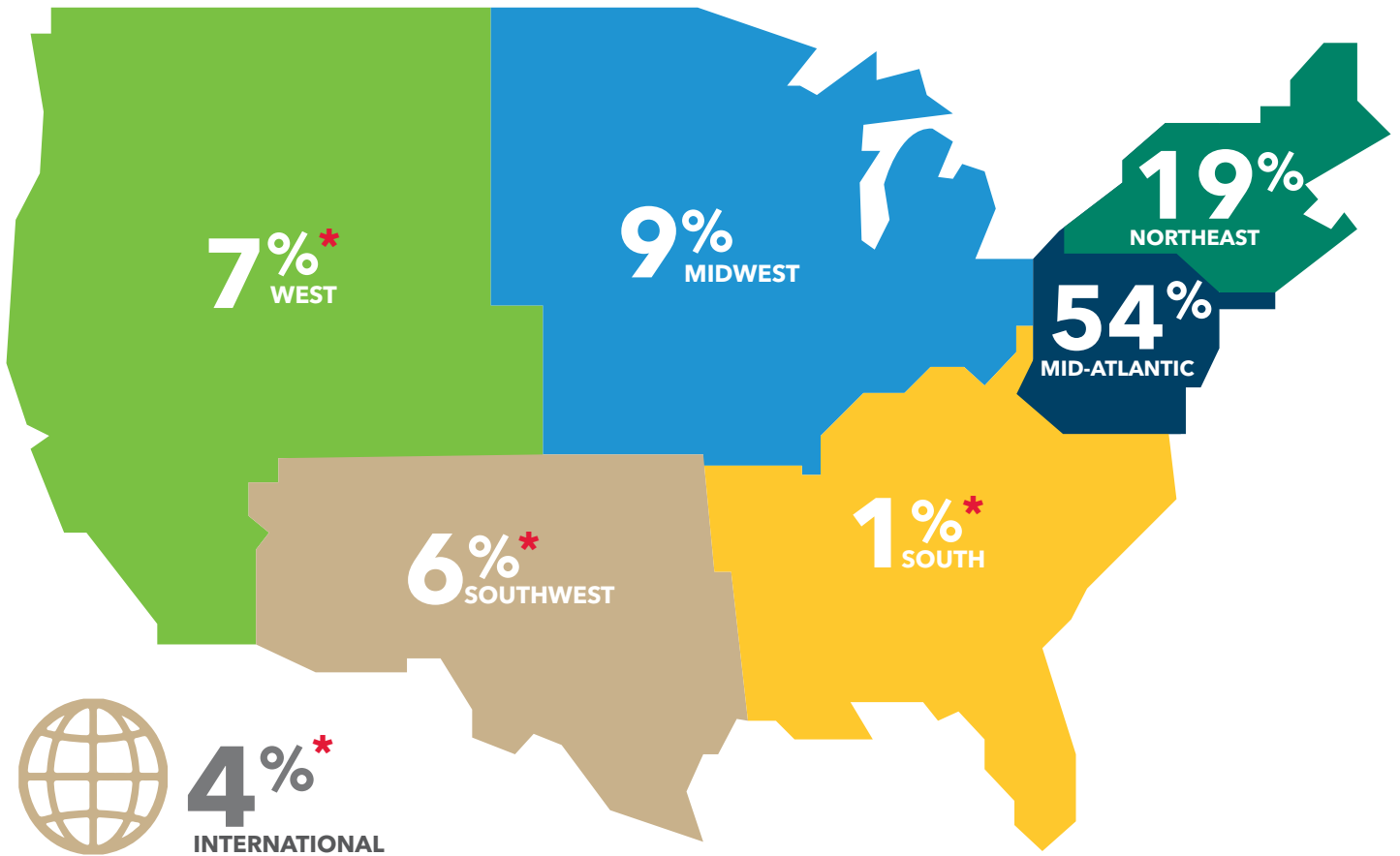

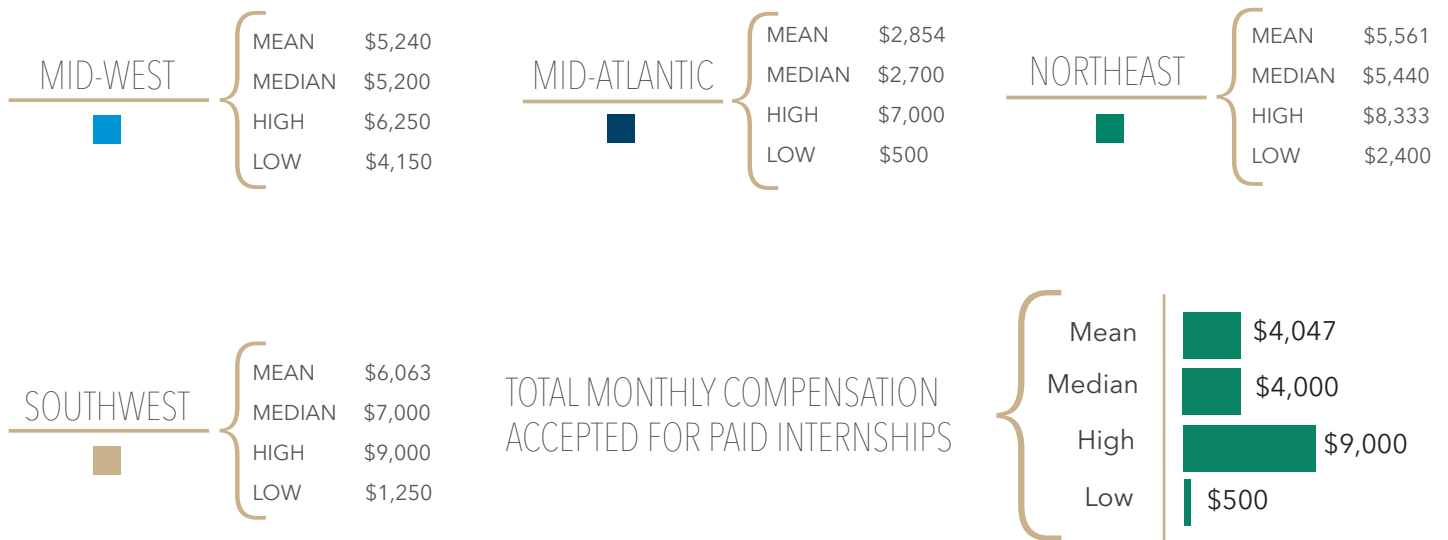
